Creating a Healthier World for Women, Men, and Teens

For nearly a century, Planned Parenthood® has been the nation's leading sexual and reproductive health care provider and advocate. Planned Parenthood health centers and international partners provide contraception, testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections (STIs), and lifesaving cancer screenings to millions of people in the U.S. and 10 other countries. With a presence in all 50 states and Washington, DC, Planned Parenthood has 79 affiliates, which operate nearly 800 health centers.

- One in five women in the U.S. has visited a Planned Parenthood health center.
- Planned Parenthood health centers provide health care that helps women prevent an estimated 584,000 unintended pregnancies and 277,000 abortions every year.
- Planned Parenthood's local partners in 10 countries serve 900,000 individuals.
- Planned Parenthood websites, including Planned Parenthood en Español, receive an estimated 33 million visits each year.
- Seventy-six percent of Planned Parenthood health care patients live with incomes of 150 percent of the federal poverty level or less, the equivalent of about \$33,000 a year for a family of four.
- Every year, Planned Parenthood affiliates provide
  - family planning counseling and contraception to 2.2 million patients
  - more than 1.1 million pregnancy tests
  - 770,000 Pap tests, identifying about 94,000 women at risk of developing cervical cancer
  - nearly 750,000 lifesaving breast exams, helping alert patients to possible cancers
  - more than four million tests and treatments for sexually transmitted infections, including HIV
  - nearly 1.5 million emergency contraception kits
  - education programs to nearly 1.1 million people
