The teen birth rate increased between 2006 and 2007 for the second straight year after 14 consecutive years of declines

The recent increase in the teen birth rate after a decade long decline suggests that we need to look at what pregnancy prevention initiatives really work. According to The National Campaign to Prevent Teen and Unplanned Pregnancy, teen pregnancy is closely linked to critical social issues like poverty and overall child well-being.

But young people say that more parental involvement, better sex and relationship education, and a more realistic portrayal of the consequences of teen pregnancy in popular culture may help reverse the recent increase in the teen birth rate.

- *demonstrate what you can do to empower teens to protect their health
