It is crucial that adults provide a consistent message to young people, especially when it concerns sexual health. For example, how do you promote abstinence while encouraging the use of condoms at the same time? Is this a consistent message, is it a mixed message? This training will enhance the communication and messaging skills as they relate to sexuality issues. However, many of the strategies addressed during this training can be used with other challenging topics. The training will incorporate a variety of methods including interactive games, discussion and practice of skills.

Upon completion, participants will be able to:

- Identify the factors that affect a person's ability to address sexuality issues with young people
- Determine how messages can be consistent and relevant to youth and what strategies enhance communication with young people
- Determine what information is being requested and what young people want when they ask challenging questions and how to address challenging questions and issues by using a model that promotes continuous, healthy conversations
