



William G. Robertson, Jr.



Respected and loved volunteer William G. Robertson Jr. passed away at age 93 on February 25, 2007. Bill had been involved with Planned Parenthood of Maryland for over 60 years. He came to PPM through his first wife, Linda G. Nes, who was on our board starting in 1935. Linda served on the board again during the 1950s and 1960s.

Bill joined the board in 1964, and was the only person ever to be named a “board member emeritus.” An engineer by trade, he helped with the design of the 610 North Howard Street headquarters building in the 1970s. He was also responsible for securing the two largest single legacy gifts for PPM, helping to start our Endowment.

During this time, Bill made the decision to leave his own generous legacy gift to the PPM Endowment. Our Endowment is now valued at over \$11 million, and we owe much of the credit to Bill.
