

Our Mission

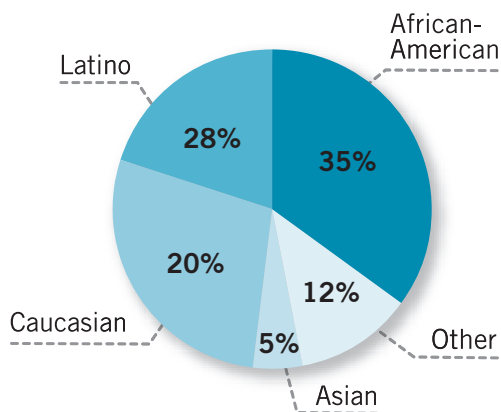

Our Clients

- In 2010, nearly 50,000 clients made more than 83,000 visits to our four health centers. We reached an additional 48,500 people through Project Street Beat.
- In 2010, more than 74% of our clients were under the age of 29 and the vast majority were women.
- Our clients are diverse: In 2010, 35% were African-American, 28% Latino, 20% Caucasian, 5% Asian, and 12% Other.
- 66% of our clients in 2010 were insured by Medicaid, paid reduced rates, or received our services for free.

Our Role in the Community

Reproductive Health Services

At our four health centers in Manhattan, Brooklyn, the Bronx, and Staten Island, highly trained professionals provide state-of-the-art reproductive health care. Whether the people we serve need contraception, a pregnancy test, or abortion counseling and services, we're here for our clients – regardless of their age or ability to pay. Our health center staff is prepared to serve diverse communities. Medical interpretation for non-English-speaking clients is available.

PPNYC's Focus on Teens

Clinical Services has partnered with PPNYC's Education and Training Department to host monthly "Teen Nights" at our Bronx, Brooklyn, and Manhattan health centers. Young people are invited into our centers for these special teen events, which include workshops presented by our Teen Advocates and Education staff on various reproductive health topics, including sexually transmitted infections, pregnancy prevention, and more. After the workshops, the teens have an opportunity to be seen by a PPNYC clinician.

Preventing the Spread of HIV/AIDS and Other Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs)

We offer HIV/AIDS education, counseling, and rapid testing, as well as screening and treatment for other STIs.

Project Street Beat

Project Street Beat is an innovative client-focused, street-based HIV prevention and access-to-care program. It's known for its success in reaching individuals at high risk for HIV who don't typically access traditional health care. Project Street Beat offers evidence-based group interventions such as SISTA, Safety Counts, and Healing Our Women. In 2010, Project Street Beat had 48,500 encounters with individuals at risk and administered more than 7,000 HIV rapid tests.

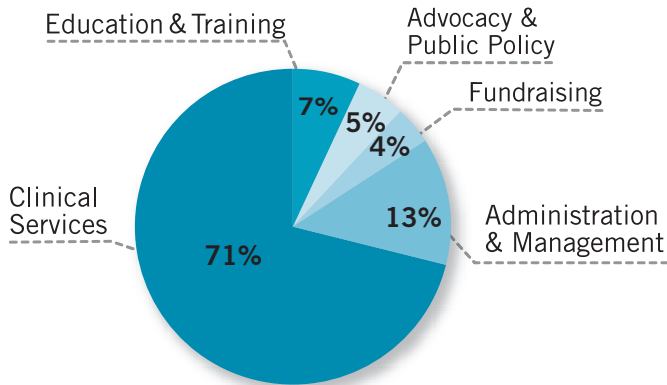


Our Services

We provide birth control; emergency contraception; pregnancy testing and options counseling (including adoption referrals); surgical abortion and medication abortion; GYN care, including cervical and breast cancer screening; colposcopy; male reproductive health exams; testing, counseling, and treatment for sexually transmitted infections; HIV testing and counseling; and help in obtaining public insurance.

- Successfully helped more than 6,900 clients obtain public insurance
- 56,000 family planning visits
- 75,000 tests for sexually transmitted infections
- 21,000 HIV tests
- 12,000 Pap tests to screen for cervical cancer
- 9,500 pregnancy tests
- Our health centers provided nearly 17,000 abortions – 92% in the first trimester
- 28% of all abortions were medication abortions
