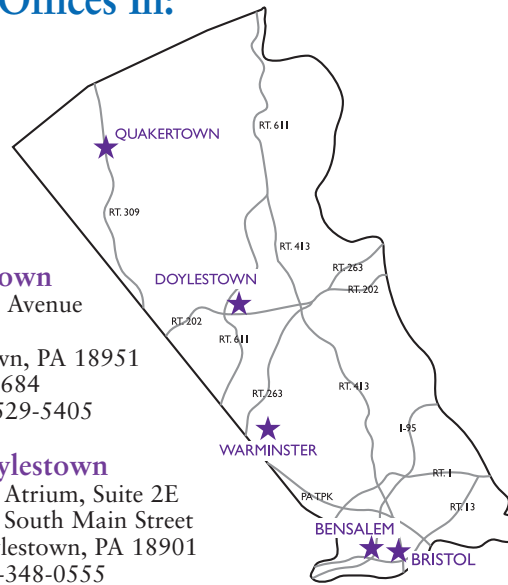

## Community Education

Sexuality is a natural, healthy, lifelong part of being human. Whether it be helping an adolescent, learning about menopause or maintaining a healthy and fulfilling relationship at any age; our workshops can help. We offer programs to community members in all settings on a wide variety of topics. Parents, we recognize you as the primary sexuality educators of your children. We also know that young people receive messages about sexuality everyday. We offer workshops for parents on a wide variety of topics including how to facilitate communication with their children about sexuality.

We welcome the opportunity to work with any group addressing any or all aspects of sexuality. Groups and settings we work with include: faith-based groups, college students, gender-specific groups, gay-straight alliances, support groups and tabling at health and community fairs.



## Youth Education

Our Education and Training Department is the recognized expert in Bucks County in the field of comprehensive sexuality education. We provide education to youth in public and private schools, alternative educational settings, community groups, substance abuse centers, youth detention facilities, and programs that serve youth with emotional, behavioral, and developmental disabilities. We work with youth on a variety of topics and present medically-accurate, age and developmentally appropriate information.

# Educating our Community

### ► After School Programs

Working in underserved communities, the Education and Training Department provides after-schools programs, which offer fun and educational activities for youth in their own communities. We work to create healthy relationships for youth among their peers and with the adults who serve as role models. Our after-school programs strive to offer excellent programming in the areas of sexuality education, self-esteem, life skills and social skills.

### ► The Rainbow Room

The Rainbow Room is a safe, supportive and welcoming environment for LGBTQA (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Questioning, Queer and Allied) youth ages 14 to 21. It features educational, advocacy and recreational activities. We value the leadership and active involvement of youth in program planning and operations by collaborating with the Rainbow Room's Youth Advisory Council. We also offer resources for adult allies of LGBTQ youth.

### ► Peer Education Theater Troupe

Peer Education can help young people receive medically accurate, factual and helpful information about sexuality in the most effective means possible. Our highly trained Peer Educators use theatre to educate, entertain, and advocate on important issues like Sexually Transmitted Infections and HIV/AIDS, Safer Sex, LGBTQ Issues and Planned Parenthood services.

### ► Professional Development

For professionals working with youth or adults, one of the most complex aspects of their work can be answering questions and addressing concerns around issues of sexuality. Our professional development training offers the opportunity to learn about sexuality, gain new skills in addressing sexuality issues and to explore feelings and frustrations that staff may encounter dealing with all age groups. We offer professional development to any agency, school or business. Our programs are tailored to meet the specific needs of the professionals we are working with.

### ► Resource Center

The Resource Center maintains current information and resources on sexual health including: films and videos, pamphlets, books, teaching aids, sexuality education curricula, safer sex supplies and journals and reports. The Center is available to anyone in the community – parents, teachers, professional and youth. It is updated on an on-going basis to ensure the most current and accurate information is available.
