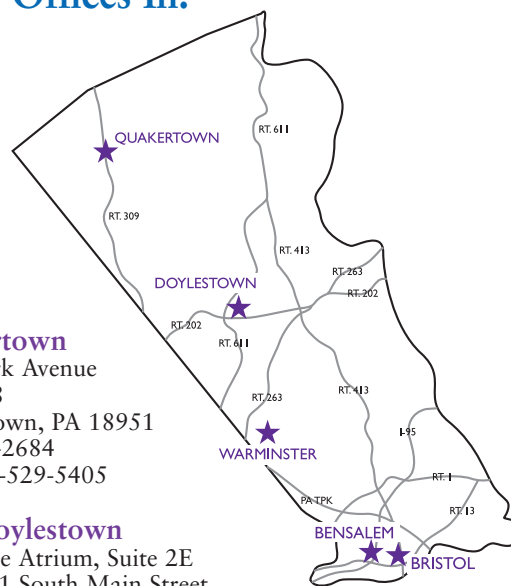

Birth Control and Safer Sex

Most methods of birth control and safer sex supplies

Sexually Transmitted Infection Testing and Treatment/HIV Testing

Risk reduction education and confidential testing and treatment including traditional and rapid HIV testing

Emergency Contraception Services

Emergency Contraception helps prevent pregnancy when taken within 120 hours of unprotected sex.

Pregnancy Testing and Options Counseling

Walk-in hours, information, and referrals are available for prenatal care, adoption, and abortion.

Abortion Services

First trimester surgical and medication abortion services provided in the Warminster office

Gynecological Exams

Pelvic exams, Pap tests, breast exams and mammography referrals, colposcopy, and LEEP (follow-up for abnormal Pap test results).

Services for Men

Health exams, STI/STD testing and treatment, and cancer screening

Mid-life Services

Education and medical care for women in menopause or peri-menopause, including hormone replacement and alternative therapies

Tobacco Cessation

Counseling and education to become tobacco free

▶ Medical Offices

Our medical offices are staffed by dedicated and compassionate nurse practitioners, health care assistants, and physicians trained in reproductive and sexual health issues. We stress preventive health care, privacy and patient education.

▶ Education and Training

We provide comprehensive, medically accurate, age appropriate sexuality education, professional training, and consulting for youth and professionals in schools and other settings. We strive to ensure that sexuality is understood as an essential, lifelong aspect of being human, and that it is celebrated with respect, openness, and mutuality. We operate the Rainbow Room, the only center for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, questioning and allied (LGBTQA) youth in the region, a peer education/youth theater program, and facilitate after-school sexuality education groups for some of the most marginalized and least affluent youth in our region.
