SelectPlan for Women is a voluntary, free, and confidential program for women residing in Pennsylvania to help you stay healthy. If eligible, this program pays for all or part of your family planning products and services.

We have a helpful checklist to make sure your application is processed with convenience and accuracy. Please make sure you bring all of the materials and information listed below to your appointment.

If you have any questions, please check our website or call your closest Planned Parenthood Association of Bucks County health center.

- Proof of identity and that you are a US citizen or have satisfactory immigration status (e.g. birth certificate or immigration documents)
- Proof of Pennsylvania residency (e.g. driver's license or state-issued ID)
- Proof of income—YOU WILL NEED THIS TO COMPLETE THE APPLICATION. Proof of income includes, but is not limited to:
 - Pay stubs, award letters, pay checks or current tax return
 - Pay stubs should represent a full month's income. An employer's letter that states your monthly gross income is also acceptable
 - If self-employed, copies of tax returns or other business financial records are acceptable
 - If you are receiving child support, please include it as income
 - If you are receiving unemployment, please include it as income
 - If you are married, please include income information for both you and your spouse
- Completed SelectPlan for Women Application—when completing the information regarding household, please include only family members and dependents that reside with you; do not include dependents living in other states or households

If you are under age 18 or over age 44, currently pregnant or sterilized, live outside of PA, are not a US citizen or do not have satisfactory immigration status, or have insurance that covers family planning services, you are not eligible for Select Plan.
