We will be demonstrating to bring visibility to the Transgender Community, and their issues, which are often overlooked. We will be finishing the event with a candlelight visual and speakers on the lawn outside of the courthouse. Rainbow Room has a long history of serving the LGBT youth in our area and we are deeply dedicated to not leaving out the Transgender members of our community.

The Transgender Day of Remembrance has been memorializing the victims of anti-transgender violence for eleven years now. Although most people will agree that hate crimes are wrong, violence against minorities still happens in our society. Many people don’t have the knowledge to speak out against biased crimes and we would like to expand their understanding about being Transgender or Gender Queer.

The Transgender Day of Remembrance will take place in communities all over the world, and we are looking forward to adding the community of Doylestown to that list.
