

The Extended Gestational Age Medical Abortion Study

You are being invited to participate in this research study because you are between 8 and 10 weeks pregnant and you want to have an abortion. Mifepristone-misoprostol medical abortion is a way of ending a pregnancy using pills. Currently, only women who are 9 weeks pregnant or less can have a medical abortion; women who are over 9 weeks pregnant and want to end their pregnancies must have an abortion with surgery. This study is testing whether mifepristone-misoprostol medical abortion is effective for abortion in women who are 9-10 weeks pregnant. The results of this study may make medical abortion available to women who are one week further into their pregnancies.

If you are 9-10 weeks pregnant, participation in this study will allow you to have a medical abortion. If you are 8-9 weeks pregnant, you can have a medical abortion without participating in this study. However, if you do choose to participate in this study you may be helping women who are one week further into their pregnancies get a medical abortion instead of a surgical one. Compensation for participation is \$60.
