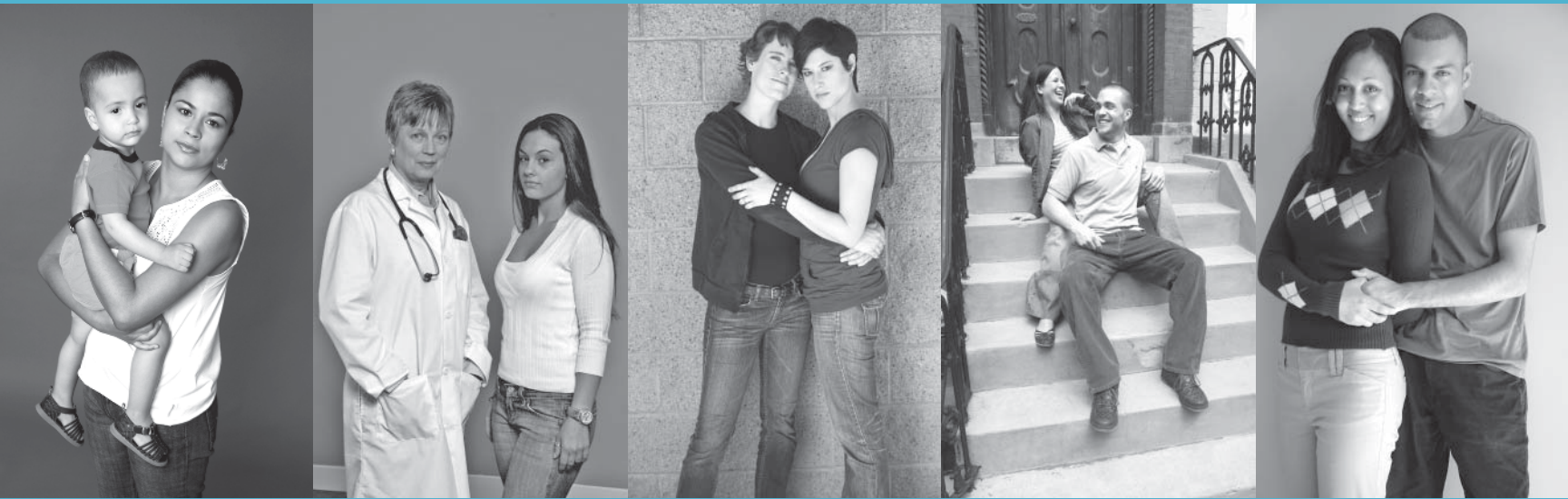

Our education programs reach all of the Counties in our turf: Humboldt, Del Norte and Trinity.

In the last year, our health center staff worked with clients to address their needs in the most sensitive, non-judgmental, and accurate manner possible. Individual circumstances ranged from helping a female patient who had not had a pap smear (cancer screening) in almost 20 years due to sexual abuse, to addressing relationship violence and domestic abuse in our Outreach program, to treating a patient who recently learned that his partner was HIV positive and immediately came to SRPP for STD testing and counseling. Last year, our staff served 20,935 patient visits for an increase of 13% over the previous year. More people are in need of services as unemployment rises, but equally, clients are taking advantage of the fact that we take private insurance, administer health and wellness check ups for men as well as women, and have bilingual staff available. We thank you for choosing us for your reproductive health care needs.

Patient Services

- In 2008-2009, we began offering Implanon, a new form of birth control. Implanon is a thin, flexible plastic implant about the size of a cardboard matchstick. It is inserted under the skin of the upper arm and protects against pregnancy for up to three years. With typical use, Implanon is 99.95% effective.
- We expanded the availability of colposcopy, resulting in a 150% increase in colposcopy appointments over the last year. One key way of detecting cancer cells early is to have a colposcopy procedure.
- Our total patient visits increased 13% to 20,935.
- We had nearly 8,900 unduplicated patients.
- We dispensed over 8,150 boxes of emergency contraception (EC).
- Our Medical Outreach program had 1,884 visits, primarily young adults 25 and under, for birth control and other non-exam services.



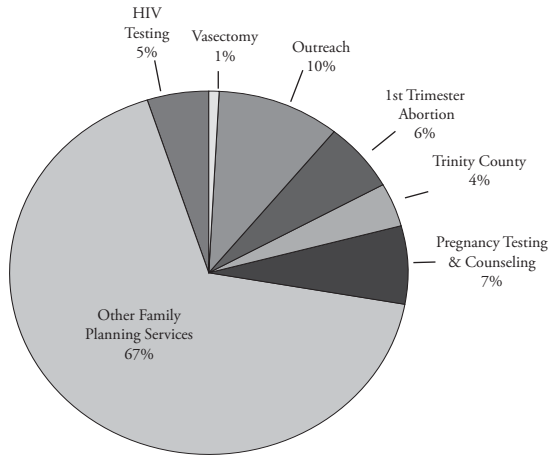

Patient Services

- First trimester abortion services comprised approximately 6% of our medical services. One third of abortion patients chose medication abortion.
- We began inserting IUDs for interested patients immediately following surgical abortion in February 2008. Approximately 30% of patients chose this option.



From the Clinic

Not too long ago, Laurie brought her daughter in to SRPP to get birth control. She was so impressed with the services here that she decided to start getting her own annual exams at our clinic. In addition to becoming a patient, Laurie wanted to help the cause and get involved further by becoming a volunteer.

Education

- In 2008-09, health educators presented medically accurate sexual health education programs for 1,391 youth in 25 schools in Humboldt County and 239 youth in ten schools in Trinity County. For the first time ever, we were invited to Orleans to work with 7th and 8th grade students.
- Spare Change peer educators performed educational theater at 16 locations, including ten high schools. The group also made classroom presentations about healthy relationships at seven middle schools. One highlight of the Spare Change Program was a performance on the steps of the state capitol. The trip to Sacramento was funded by the Walt Whitman Humboldt Area Foundation Fund which supports education that provides a greater understanding of the issues faced by gay youth.
- SRPP's international advocate, Frederica Aalto, presented a three session course on population and international family planning.

Education

- In Del Norte County, SRPP educators provided sexual education training for teachers. In addition, Del Norte Teen Outreach, an after-school program, met weekly for teen pregnancy prevention activities.
- Staff and volunteers tabled at nine community events and health fairs with information about our services.
- Our newly launched Midlife/Menopause educational series, offered in cooperation with the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute, was a hit. An educated group of professionals volunteered their time to speak in front of a packed room.
- Working with the Paso a Paso Program for Latino parents, we presented a parent/child communication workshop in Spanish.

Public Affairs

- 185 supporters attended the 27th Annual Choices Breakfast commemorating the 36th anniversary of Roe v. Wade. At the event, Jennet Arcara, an international health policy specialist, discussed the work done by Venture Strategies. Venture Strategies is a non-profit agency working to improve public health in developing countries. Ms. Arcara educated attendees on the efforts to increase access to birth control and safe abortion internationally.
- Nancy Dye, a long time SRPP volunteer and Chair of Clergy for Choice, was presented with the annual Maggie Award at the Choices Breakfast in recognition of her hard work on behalf of reproductive rights.
- Starting in August 2008, volunteers participated in statewide phone banks to contact registered voters and urge a “no” vote on Prop. 4 (the latest Parental Notification Initiative). SRPP phone bankers made contact with over 2,000 voters. Combined with the efforts of Planned Parenthood Affiliates throughout California, over 150,000 voters were contacted statewide.

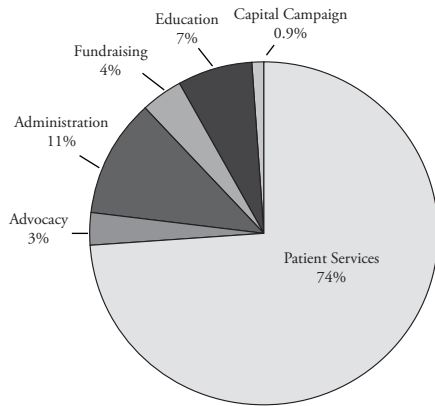

- Four house parties/events were held in various locations throughout Humboldt County, and along with other fundraising efforts, raised \$15,000 for the campaign against Prop. 4. All of the hard work paid off in November when Prop. 4 was defeated at the ballot box.
- Nine staff and volunteers attended this year's Planned Parenthood Capitol Day in Sacramento where we educated our representatives on the importance of reproductive health.
- SRPP staff, supporters, volunteers, and patients made over 400 contacts with our legislators during the budget battle. Statewide efforts from our supporters kept Family-PACT and funding for reproductive health care from devastating cuts.

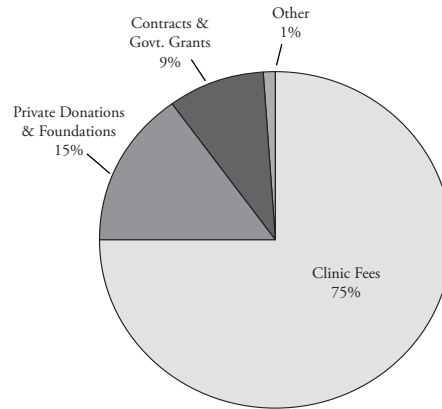

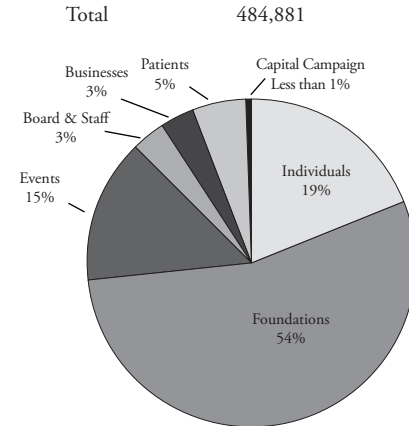
