Fact Sheet

Since 1932, Planned Parenthood of the St. Louis Region has been the leader in providing comprehensive family planning, reproductive and sexual health care services to all, especially individuals who are uninsured and at risk. PPSLR is the region's largest provider of testing and treatment of sexually transmitted infections and contraceptive services.

PPSLR by the numbers (Fiscal year 2006-2007)

Health services

6 bi-state health centers provide services 6 days a week, including weekends and evenings

33,893 patients, out of which 2,547 were males

36,237 STI tests

6,239 HIV tests, a 39% increase from the previous fiscal year

10,972 Emergency Contraception dispensed, a 14% increase from the previous fiscal year

13 Washington University School of Medicine residents were trained in the 1st year under the Ryan Residency Program

Education programs

10,005 participants in our Community Education programs at 629 sessions

162 people trained in our Professional Education programs at 24 sessions

264 teens trained in our Teen Peer Education program, with a total of 1,161 since its inception

47 male teens trained in our Boys2Men program, with a total of 423 since its inception

48 participants in Teen Advocates for Sexual Health, with a total of 154 since its inception

199,973 pro-choice Missourians identified

52,850 in our statewide Planned Parenthood "supporter list"

421 in-person lobby visits with legislative members in Missouri

89 local visibility and outreach events with 2,839 participants

18 anti-choice bills fought

6 pro-active bills filed
