Comprehensive Health of Planned Parenthood Great Plains requires all unemancipated minors seeking an abortion in the State of Oklahoma to obtain notarized written consent of the minor and one parent or legal guardian of the minor.

Both the minor and parent/legal guardian must sign an informed consent. The following is a list of documentation the minor and the parent/legal guardian need to bring with them to the appointment.

1. **Informed Consent** - The State of Oklahoma requires that state-directed informed consent information must be obtained at least 72 hours before the scheduled appointment. It can be obtained by the following methods:

- a. Calling to speak to health service staff at Health Center
- b. Stopping by the Health Center and speaking to health services staff

2. **Notarized Minor and Parental Consent Form** - It can be obtained by the following methods. *This form can be filled out at time of appointment.*

- a. [Print out the Notarized Minor and Parental Consent Form online](#)
- b. Parent/guardian will be required to provide a copy of a government issued ID that will be photo copied at the appointment time, and written documentation showing a lawful parent/guardian relationship to the minor patient.

NOTE: The form can be notarized by your local notary or at the time of the appointment.

4. **Government Issued ID of parents or guardian-**

- a. State issued ID (driver's license, etc.)
- b. School ID with name
- d. Passport
- e. Military ID

5. **Legal papers linking the minor to the parent or legal guardian-**

- a. Birth Certificate
- b. Custodial agreement or Divorce decree
- c. Guardianship paperwork
- d. Authorization for Medical treatment assigned by the courts

NOTE: If the parent's name differs from the name that appears on the birth certificate (for example, mother has remarried) documentation must be submitted verifying the parent's connection to the minor. Acceptable documentation would include:

- a) Divorce papers showing a name change
- b) Custody agreement
- c) Guardianship papers
- d) Marriage certificate showing name change of the mother

Other Important & Required Information

Parent and/or legal guardian will need to be present at the time of check-in.

If you are a minor and feel as though you would be in physical and/or mental danger if you informed your parent/guardian or if you are unable to contact your parent/guardian, please call 405-603-4884; one of our representatives is available to help. An Oklahoma District Court judge can waive the parental consent requirement, if necessary and appropriate, with a court-appointed (free) attorney, by authority 63 OS §1-740.3.
