Creating a Healthier World for Women, Men, and Young People

For more than a century, Planned Parenthood® has been one of the nation's leading providers of high-quality, affordable health care for women, men, and young people, and the nation's largest provider of sex education. Planned Parenthood health centers provide millions of people with contraception, testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections (STIs), lifesaving cancer screenings, and safe, legal abortion. With a presence in all 50 states as well as Washington, D.C., Planned Parenthood has 49 affiliates, which operate more than 600 health centers. Globally, Planned Parenthood supports local partners in nine focus countries, reaching nearly 2 million individuals with sexual and reproductive health information and services. Women, men, and young people from every community and income level view Planned Parenthood as their first-choice provider of care.

- An estimated one in five women in the U.S. has visited a Planned Parenthood health center.
- Planned Parenthood health centers provide health care that helps women prevent an estimated 395,000 unintended pregnancies in a single year.
- Planned Parenthood Global's partners provided health services to 1.76 million people and trained more than 16,000 advocates.
- Planned Parenthood websites, including Planned Parenthood en Español, receive an estimated 198 million visits in a single year.
- In 2019, of Planned Parenthood patients who report their income, nearly 70% live with incomes at or below 150% of the federal poverty level, the equivalent of \$39,300 a year for a family of four.
- Planned Parenthood affiliates provide the following services to 2.4 million patients – 39% of whom are people of color – including more than 573,000 patients who identify as Latino and nearly 350,000 patients who identify as Black:
 - family planning counseling and contraception to more than 1.8 million patients
 - more than 1 million pregnancy tests
 - more than 270,000 Pap tests
 - nearly 270,000 breast exams
 - more than 5.4 million tests and treatments for sexually transmitted infections, including more than 860,000 HIV tests, and diagnoses of more than 300,000 STIs
 - screenings to more than 75,000 women whose cancer was detected early or whose abnormalities were identified and addressed
 - more than 580,000 emergency contraception kits
 - education and outreach programs to 1.1 million people
 - more than 2.5 million people reached through digital education tools and video resources
