- Number of women, men, and young people worldwide provided with sexual and reproductive health care and education by Planned Parenthood each year: **5,400,000**
- Number of these clients served by Planned Parenthood affiliate health centers in the U.S.: **2,400,000**
- Number of these clients served by Planned Parenthood affiliate educational programs and outreach: **1,200,000**
- Number of these clients served by PPFA-supported partners in 9 developing countries: **1,800,000**
- Number of Planned Parenthood affiliates: **49** (with a presence in all 50 states and the District of Columbia)
