Planned Parenthood provides high quality, nonjudgmental and confidential reproductive and sexual health care.

Our local health centers offer the following services:

- Abortion services*
- Annual exam and pap test
- Birth control methods: hormonal and barrier
- Breast cancer screening
- Colposcopy and LEEP*
- Emergency contraception
- Vaccines (HPV and Hepatitis B)
- IUDs and Implants
- PP Direct-Online services for BC pills and UTI
- PrEP and PEP for HIV prevention
- Pregnancy testing and all options counseling
- Rapid HIV testing
- STD testing and treatment
- UTI, vaginal and yeast infection testing and treatment

Payment and Insurance

Planned Parenthood accepts most major insurance plans, Medicaid and Managed care. We offer a cash discount for all our family planning services and financial assistance may be available. Ask for more information when making your appointment.
