



Thank you for making your online appointment. Bring your photo ID and your insurance card, so we may verify if the procedure is covered. If you have any additional questions, please call us at (210) 736-2262.

We are committed to providing care no matter what. Please note that at your appointment you will speak with a health professional about your medical information, all of your options, and will be able to ask questions. Your medical history will be reviewed at the time of your appointment as certain medications and medical conditions may not allow for an In-Clinic Abortion.

In-Clinic Procedure

Information regarding your visit:

Your visit will last between 2-4 hours.

You will receive the following services during your visit:

- Vaginal ultrasound
- Lab work
- Education session
- Abortion procedure and spend more time in our recovery room

Please make sure you eat before your appointment. For this appointment, there are no restrictions on food. You are welcome to bring a support person. Any support person **MUST** have

photo ID if you wish for them to be part of your visit.

We ask that you not use over the counter medications, alcohol or street drugs for at least 24 hours prior to your appointment.

Please have sanitary pads available at home for at least 2 weeks' worth of bleeding. Please wear loose and comfortable clothing and underwear that can hold a maxi pad.

It is preferred and helpful that children do not accompany you to this appointment due to the long visit length. If you must be accompanied by children, a separate responsible adult is required at all times to care for the child in the waiting area.

Things to bring to your appointment:

- A photo ID
- A list of all current medications you are taking
- Payment can be made with a credit card or money order
