

Sexually Transmitted Infection Testing

- We may need to collect a urine sample to test for some sexually transmitted infections. To ensure an accurate test result, please do not urinate for one hour prior to your appointment.
- HIV testing is done in one of two ways:
 - Rapid HIV tests give you results in about 1 minute and use a small amount of blood from a finger prick.
 - Another way to test for HIV is to send a blood sample to a lab. Your blood will be drawn and results take a few days. Your health care provider will talk to you about the best option for you.
- All services at Planned Parenthood of Michigan (PPMI) are of the highest quality and affordably priced. **Payment in full is required at the time of service.** We accept cash, money order, Discover, MasterCard, or Visa.
- Planned Parenthood accepts most insurance, including Michigan Medicaid. Please bring a photo ID and your insurance card to your appointment.
- Payment for services, including Co-pays and other patient responsible payments not covered by your insurance are expected at the time of service. If you have questions regarding what services are covered, please contact your insurance company. We will bill your insurance for the services you receive where applicable. Your out-of-pocket cost is determined by your insurance plan. We do our best to provide the highest quality care to our patients, however your insurance company has the best expertise regarding coverage. Some insurance plan coverage types may require a referral for your visit with PPMI. Please contact your insurance company to determine if your desired service is subject to referral.
- If you do not have insurance, please visit www.michigan.gov/mibridges to determine if you are eligible for insurance through the State of Michigan.
- A staff person will ask you for information about your household income to identify any discounts for which you may be eligible.
- For their own safety, children must be under the supervision of an adult at all times. Children not in carriers will not be allowed in patient care areas. If you plan to bring children with you to your appointment, please bring a responsible adult who is able to watch them while you receive your care. Our staff are unable to supervise children.
