Sexually Transmitted Infection Testing

Thank you for choosing Planned Parenthood of Michigan (PPMI) for your reproductive and sexual health care. We strive to exceed your expectations by providing high quality, inclusive, nonjudgmental, care. Our goal is to offer care that puts you in the center. We will give you information and support so you can make the best decisions for your health.

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If you are not experiencing symptoms or have a known exposure, this visit will likely not be with a licensed clinician, but with a trained medical assistant. This visit includes tests for chlamydia, gonorrhea, and a rapid HIV test. Although the medical assistant is able to answer basic questions, they cannot give a clinical assessment or dispense medication. If you have a known exposure to an STI or feel you need testing beyond chlamydia, gonorrhea, and HIV, you may want to schedule a visit with a licensed clinician. If you have questions about your scheduled visit or which option is best for you, please call us at 723-926-4800.

Rapid HIV testing is done in the health center and results are available before the end of your visit.

Samples are collected in the health center for other tests and then sent to an outside lab. Results are typically available in less than a week but can occasionally take longer.

We ask that you do not bring children to your in-person visit. We know that this is sometimes unavoidable, and we will do our best to provide you the care you need while ensuring the safety of you and everyone in our health centers.

We require all people wear a mask while in the health center. You will be screened for COVID symptoms and exposure when you arrive. If you have any symptoms of COVID-19 or a recent high-risk exposure, please cancel and reschedule your appointment when resolved.

FEES, PAYMENT, AND INSURANCE

Planned Parenthood accepts many insurance plans, including Michigan Medicaid. We also offer an income-based sliding fee scale for patients. All fees, including co-pays, are due at the time of service.

If you do not have insurance, please visit www.michigan.gov/mibridges to determine if you are eligible for insurance through the State of Michigan.

If using insurance, bring a photo ID and your insurance card to your appointment.

If you have questions regarding what services are covered by your insurance, please contact your insurance company. We will bill your insurance for the services you receive where

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applicable. We do our best to provide the highest quality care to our patients; however your insurance company has the best expertise regarding coverage. Some insurance plan coverage types may require a referral for your visit with Planned Parenthood of Michigan. Please contact your insurance company to determine if your desired service is subject to referral.
