What We Do

Reproductive Health Services

Our five health centers in Manhattan, Brooklyn, the Bronx, Queens, and Staten Island provide state-of-the-art sexual and reproductive health care. Whether the need is for contraception, pregnancy tests, abortion services, or tests for sexually transmitted infections, we're here for our patients - regardless of their age, gender, immigration status, or ability to pay. Medical interpretation and translated materials are available for non-English-speaking patients.

Clinical Training and Research Initiative

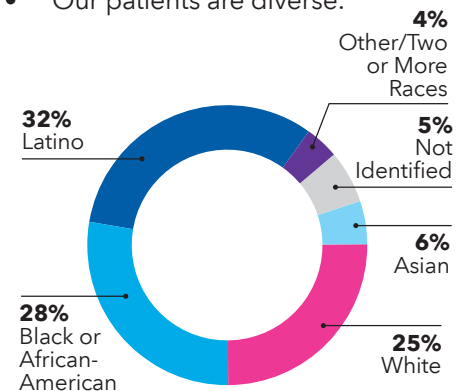
PPNYC's Clinical Training and Research Initiative (CTRI) trains a wide range of professionals including physicians, nurses, certified nurse-midwives, physician assistants, and nurse practitioners. Our trainings increase the number of clinicians certified to provide abortion services as well as the full range of sexual and reproductive health services, including the latest methods of long-acting reversible contraception. CTRI is also a strategic leader in clinical research, contributing to the provision of evidence-based medicine.

Long-Acting Reversible Contraception

More and more patients are requesting long-acting reversible contraception (LARC) - intrauterine devices (IUDs) and the contraceptive implant. In 2016, our clinicians performed 12,026 LARC insertions. We are grateful to the Jerome L. Greene Foundation for a grant that has increased access to LARC methods by covering the cost for uninsured patients who pay out of pocket.

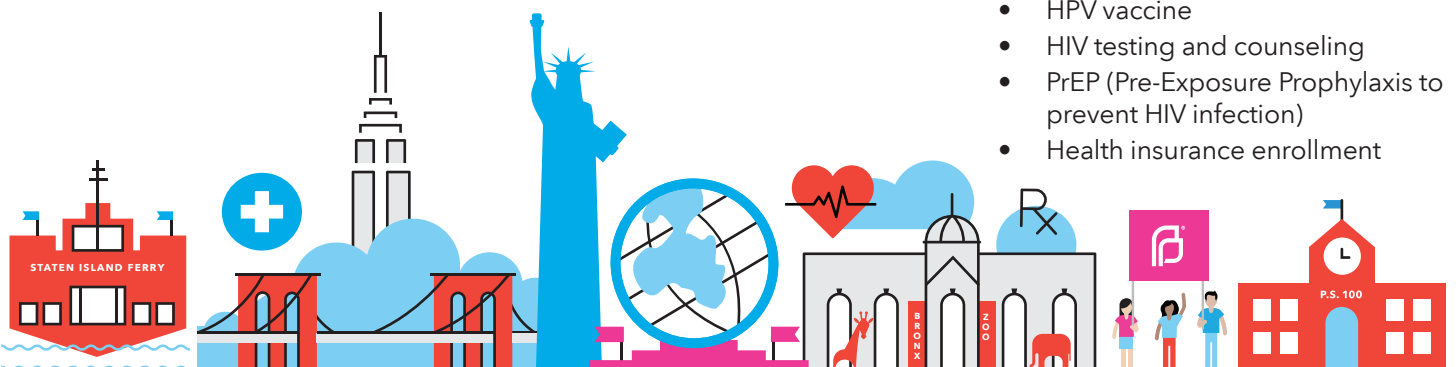
Our Patients in 2016

- More than **60,000** patients made 97,013 visits to our health centers.
- **60%** of our patients were insured by Medicaid, paid reduced rates, or received our services for free.
- **71%** of our patients were under the age of 30 and the vast majority were women.

Services Available for Patients of All Genders

- Breast exams
- Cervical cancer screening (Pap test)
- Wellness exams
- Gynecological care
- Birth control methods, including vasectomy
- Emergency contraception ("the morning-after pill")
- Pregnancy testing and options counseling
- Surgical and medication abortion
- Transgender hormone therapy
- Testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections
- HPV vaccine
- HIV testing and counseling
- PrEP (Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis to prevent HIV infection)
- Health insurance enrollment



Affordable Services

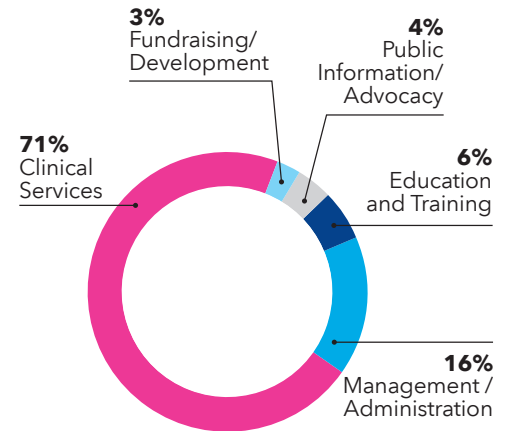
Our doors are open to everyone, regardless of their ability to pay. We help eligible uninsured patients to obtain public insurance or provide care on a sliding fee scale. Each of our health centers has counselors who help patients enroll in public insurance programs such as Medicaid, Child Health Plus, and the Family Planning Benefit Program and in the private insurance plans in the New York State of Health Marketplace.

Project Street Beat

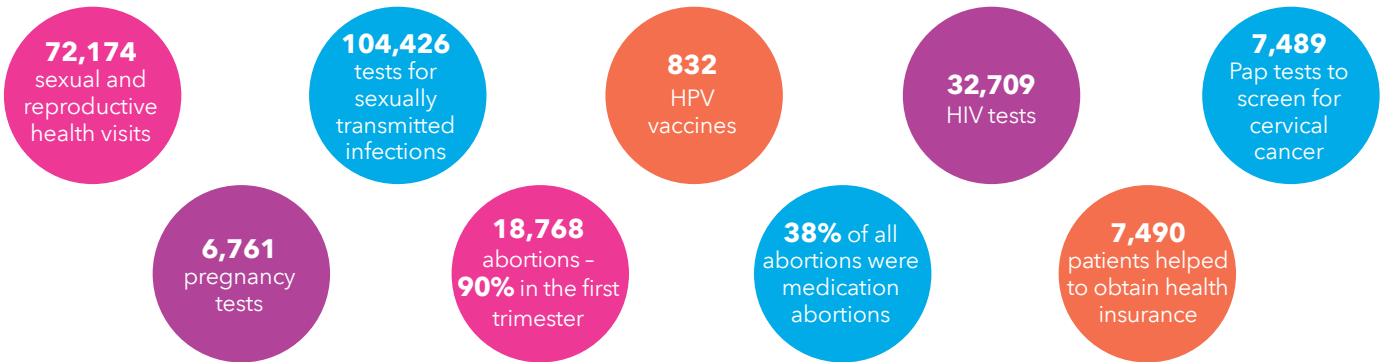
Project Street Beat is a long-trusted provider of health care services in the Bronx, Brooklyn, and northern Manhattan. Our staff work with New York City's most marginalized individuals who are at high risk for transmission of HIV and sexually transmitted infections (STI). In our mobile medical unit, minivans, and two offices, we offer HIV and STI testing, condoms, PrEP (Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis), reproductive health care, opioid overdose prevention, syringe distribution and disposal, harm reduction counseling, case management, and more. In 2016, Project Street Beat provided 13,688 services of all types.
