For a century, Planned Parenthood® has been one of the nation's leading providers of high-quality, affordable health care for women, men, and young people, and the nation's largest provider of sex education. Planned Parenthood health centers provide contraception, testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections (STIs), and lifesaving cancer screenings to millions of people in the U.S. With a presence in all 50 states and Washington, DC, Planned Parenthood has 56 affiliates, which operate more than 600 health centers. Globally, Planned Parenthood supports local partners in 12 focus countries, reaching over 1.5 million individuals with reproductive health information and services. Women, men, and young people from every community and income level view Planned Parenthood as their first-choice provider of care.

- An estimated one in five women in the U.S. has visited a Planned Parenthood health center.
- Planned Parenthood health centers provide health care that helps women prevent an estimated 560,000 unintended pregnancies in a single year.
- Planned Parenthood Global's partners reach 350,000 people through in-person educational activities and more than 230,000 people through the innovative and award-winning Global Mobile sites in a single year.
- Planned Parenthood websites, including Planned Parenthood en Español, receive an estimated 68 million visits in a single year.
- Seventy-five percent of Planned Parenthood health care patients live with incomes of 150 percent of the federal poverty level or less, the equivalent of \$36,900 a year for a family of four in 2017.
- Planned Parenthood affiliates provide the following services to 2.4 million patients, more than one-third whom are people of color, including nearly 500,000 patients that identify as Latino and nearly 360,000 patients that identify as Black:
 - family planning counseling and contraception to nearly 2 million patients
 - more than 1 million pregnancy tests
 - nearly 300,000 Pap tests
 - more than 320,000 lifesaving breast exams
 - screenings to 72,000 women whose cancer was detected early or whose abnormalities were identified and addressed
 - more than 4.2 million tests and treatments for sexually transmitted infections, including more than 650,000 HIV tests, and diagnoses of nearly 210,000 STIs
 - nearly 770,000 emergency contraception kits
 - education programs and outreach to 1.5 million people
