The Ohio Center for Sex Education is seeking workshop proposals for the 2019 Ohio Sex Education Summit: A Community Convening on Sexual Health Education and Health Equity. The event will take place at Tri C's Corporate College East on Friday, October 11, 2019. **We encourage you to share your creativity, knowledge, and vision.**

The Summit will bring over 200 community members, educators, social service professionals, elected officials, reproductive and social justice activists, and others together to share a day of learning and conversation surrounding the topic of sexual health education. Celebrating important achievements while lifting up opportunities for growth, the Summit will create a diverse and inclusive atmosphere in which we can critically examine the importance of the intersection of individual and community identities. Too many Ohioans experience unacceptable disparities in health and wellness, and we will examine how sexual health education can address these problems in our communities.

### Submissions

The planning committee seeks proposals for 50-minute interactive workshop sessions. The presenters will repeat their presentation for a second rotation immediately following the first. Reviewers will look favorably upon proposals that:

- Include facilitators who bring diverse perspectives and are inclusive of all,
- Show how a session will be interactive, and
- Provide participants with clear, tangible learning objectives ideally resulting in takeaway skill building.

**Proposals are due no later than Friday, June 28 at 5:00 p.m.** Proposals will be reviewed as they are submitted. Everyone that submits a proposal will be notified no later than Monday, July 8 on the status of their proposal. Workshop spaces are limited so you are encouraged to submit your proposal early.
