

Planned Parenthood of Metropolitan New Jersey Payment Options

Male Patients:

Because your time is valuable to us, please call your preferred health center upon making your appointment to confirm the provider is licensed to examine male patients.

Implant/ IUC Procedures:

If you are a new patient or have not seen our clinician in the last 6 months, it is possible this type of procedure will be deferred due to your reproductive health history. All procedures are upon clinician discretion. If done elsewhere, bring a copy of recent pap and STI results from other doctor's office.

In-Network Insurances:

If you are covered by a healthcare plan, you must bring in your insurance cards and a picture ID on the day of service. **If there are co-pays associated with your visit, you must also pay it on the day of service.**

Medicaid plans:

PPMNJ accepts NJ Medicaid plans. Your insurance maybe associated with a plan type. Plan types A, B, C, & ABP will cover your entire visit; whereas plan types H.I.D. or E offers limited services that only cover your pharmacy expenses. Patients must bring in CCN and HMO cards that are associated with your NJ Medicaid Plan, also if copay is associated with your plan type bring in the full fee amount.

Medicare:

PPMNJ does not accept Medicare or Medicare/ Medicaid combination plans. Call your insurance company to find a Doctor that accepts these combine plans.

Self-Pay:

If you do not have insurance nor qualify for healthcare coverage, your services are rendered on a sliding fee scale. To determine the cost of your visit, please bring in proof of income (paystub, W-2, unemployment checks/ form, child support document). **Payment expected at the time of service.** We accept payment in cash, debit or credit (Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express). We also accept personal checks that cannot be postdated.

Uninsured Individuals:

Our ACA specialists are available to assist you in applying for NJ Medicaid or other insurances available through the Affordable Care Act. Upon scheduling an appointment, please call our Certified Application Counselors at (973) 699-5577 & (973) 902-1920, to meet with you on the date of service.
