


 **PHYSICAL LOCATIONS**


OUR NEW VIRTUAL HEALTH CENTER: TELEHEALTH

We had **2,250** telehealth appointments between when it was first introduced on **April 22, 2020** and the end of our fiscal year on **June 30, 2020**.

Reasons for Telehealth Visits:

- 56.9%** Family Planning & Contraception
- 21.6%** Transgender Care
- 17.7%** STI Testing & Treatment
- 3.4%** Pregnancy Testing
- 0.4%** Other

All service numbers and statistics are for fiscal year 2020, which covers the period of July 1, 2019 - June 30, 2020 unless otherwise noted.



Nearly **91%** of our patients are **female**, **9.4%** are **male**, and **0.1%** are **non-binary**.
(As self-identified by patients)

1,312
Transgender patients turn to PPSWCF for gender-affirming hormone therapy and other health care services.

Nearly **78%** of our patients are between the ages of **20** and **39**, **14%** are in their **teens**, and **8%** are **over 40** years old.


In January, we began a partnership with **Choice Network** to offer patients adoption services. Choice Network is a nationally recognized **pro-choice and LGBTQ+ affirming** adoption agency that shares our values. So far, we have referred **15** of our patients to Choice Network.

Education

Providing our community with medically-accurate sexual and reproductive health information

10,034 Education Participants

Our educators held education sessions at youth shelters, foster homes, jails, juvenile justice facilities, substance-abuse treatment centers, community-based organizations like PACE Center for Girls and Boys and Girls Clubs, colleges, and in some elementary, middle and high school settings.



Advocates & Volunteers

Securing the future of reproductive rights and supporting patients as they access our health care

3,989 Advocacy Volunteers

Our organizers and volunteers advocated for reproductive justice while canvassing neighborhoods, lobbying our representatives, and phonebanking to educate our community about issues affecting health care.

- **Legislative Session** - Storytellers and volunteers from across our affiliate lobbied our elected officials and fought back against forced parental consent.
- **Occupy the Capitol** - On February 4, 2020, **67 volunteers** went to Tallahassee to Occupy the Capitol, with a total of **200 advocates** from across the state. The group took a stand against forced parental consent for abortion (SB 404/HB 265). While the dangerous legislation eventually passed, we were able to show our power and opposition against any attacks on our rights.
