



Reproductive Health Care is a Human Right

Illinois became one of the most progressive states for reproductive rights in the country with the enactment of the Reproductive Health Act (RHA). The RHA established maternal, contraceptive, and abortion care, as a fundamental right. By removing abortion from the criminal code, the RHA ensures abortion is treated like every other form of health care.

Amidst dangerous restrictions and abortion bans across the country, Illinois remains a haven for reproductive rights in the Midwest.

WINS IN 2019



Consent will be integrated into all sex education curricula in Illinois.



Maternal health will be prioritized as Illinois expands care for pregnant and postpartum moms.



Equal pay will be strengthened by prohibiting employers from asking for wage or salary history.

JULY 2018

CHAT Goes Back to School

PPIL's Chicago Healthy Adolescents and Teens (CHAT) program brought sex education, one-on-one counseling, and free sexually transmitted infection (STI) testing to more than 12,000 young people.

AUGUST 2018

Expanding LGBTQ Care

Gender Affirming Hormone Therapy (GAHT) expanded to all 17 PPIL health centers across the state, providing nonjudgmental and compassionate care to transgender patients.

Generations Celebration

Forward Illinois, a coalition of progressive organizations including PPIL, launched to address issues that impact patients outside of the health centers, and create a safer and healthier Illinois for all.

The Chicago Healthy Adolescents and Teens (CHAT) team provides young people with sex education, one-on-one counseling, and free sexually transmitted infection (STI) testing in schools and community-based organizations across Chicago. An individual that tests positive during the CHAT program can obtain no-cost treatment at any PPIL health center without an appointment.

CHAT is passionate about equipping youth with the knowledge and resources to take control of their reproductive health.

Accessing Birth Control is as Easy as ABC

More than 2,000 patients received free birth control last year through the Access Birth Control (ABC) Initiative! Launched in January 2019, ABC ensures cost is not a barrier to family planning care. ABC allows patients to access the birth control method of their choice regardless of their personal finances or insurance coverage. ABC gives patients autonomy and freedom over their bodies.

"I saw a patient who had private insurance with limited benefits for contraceptives. She had done research on LARCs, but decided to get the birth control shot because it was all she could afford.

Once I told her about ABC, and that cost would not need to be a factor in her decision, she happily chose to get the LARC instead. **She was so grateful she could get the birth control she knew was the best fit for her!**"
