Our Mission

PPNYC is a leading provider of sexual and reproductive health services and information, a fierce advocate, and a committed partner to advance equity and improve health outcomes for all.

Clinical Services

Our five health centers in Manhattan, Brooklyn, the Bronx, Queens, and Staten Island provide state-of-the-art reproductive health care. Whether the need is for contraception, pregnancy tests, abortion services, or tests for sexually transmitted infections, we're here for our patients – regardless of their age, gender, immigration status, or ability to pay. Medical interpretation and translated materials are available for non-English-speaking patients.

Our Services

We provide birth control, including vasectomy; emergency contraception (“the morning-after pill”); wellness exams for all genders; screening for breast, cervical, and testicular cancer; colposcopy; pregnancy testing and options counseling (including adoption referrals); surgical abortion and medication abortion; gender-affirming hormone therapy; testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections; the HPV vaccine; HIV testing and counseling; the medicines PrEP (Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis) and PEP (Post-Exposure Prophylaxis) to prevent HIV infection; and help in obtaining health insurance.

Project Street Beat

Project Street Beat is a long-trusted provider of health care services in the Bronx, Brooklyn, and northern Manhattan. Our staff work with New York City's most marginalized individuals who are at high risk for transmission of HIV and sexually transmitted infections (STI). In our mobile health


center, minivans, and two offices, we offer HIV and STI testing, condoms, PrEP, PEP, reproductive health care, opioid overdose prevention, syringe distribution and disposal, harm reduction counseling, case management, and other support services.

Our Patients in 2018

- **56,577** patients made **91,409** visits to our health centers.
- **62%** of our patients were insured by Medicaid, paid reduced rates, or received our services for free.
- Our patients are diverse:
 - **35%** Latinx
 - **29%** Black or African American
 - **24%** White
 - **7%** Asian/Pacific Islander
 - **4%** Not Identified
 - **1%** Other/Two or More Races

Health Services Facts 2018

- Successfully helped **6,666** patients obtain health insurance
- **58,314** sexual and reproductive health visits and **4,907** pregnancy tests
- **92,644** tests for sexually transmitted infections
- **33,978** HIV tests
- **5,452** Pap tests to screen for cervical cancer
- **19,747** abortions – **93%** in the first trimester; **41%** were medication abortions
- **17,085** services provided by Project Street Beat





Education and Training

We offer a wide range of programs for youth, adults, and professionals.

Evidence-Based Programs

PPNYC facilitates “Making Proud Choices” and “Be Proud! Be Responsible!,” two evidence-based STI, HIV, and pregnancy prevention programs for youth aged 11-21, in schools and community organizations in the Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, and Queens.

Youth Health Promoters

Our youth peer educators inform young people about teens’ access to sexual and reproductive health care through interactive workshops and social media. These peer educators receive intensive training that helps them to develop their own skills and goals. Many of the Youth Health Promoters go on to work for community organizations where they continue providing needed assistance to young people throughout New York City.

Youth Activist Collective

Youth Activist Collective is a leadership development program for New York City teens interested in activism and movement building. Members deepen their knowledge of reproductive justice issues and lead advocacy and direct actions on issues they care about.

Now U Know

This workshop series cultivates the knowledge and skills young people need to make informed decisions about their sexual health. The workshops are available in middle and high schools and community organizations in the Bronx, Manhattan, Brooklyn, Queens, and Staten Island.

Pop-Ups

Pop-Ups are fun activities that engage young people in games and conversation in which they have an opportunity to learn about sexual and reproductive health from PPNYC’s sexuality educators. Participants can also make an appointment for health care. Pop-Ups can be arranged at schools and youth-serving organizations throughout New York City.

Adult Role Models

PPNYC’s Adult Role Models are local parents and caring adults trained to facilitate a four-part workshop series in schools and community organizations around the city to help other parents and caring adults talk with their kids about sexuality and strengthen parent-child relationships.

Promotores de Salud

The Promotores are bilingual peer health educators and advocates who seek to increase access to sexual and reproductive health information and family planning services for Latinxs in New York City through outreach, workshops, and linkage to care including medical interpretation.

Sex Education for Adults

Sex Education for Adults connects New Yorkers to sexual and reproductive health information and care by offering workshops and on-site appointment making at organizations throughout New York City, such as senior centers, shelters, support groups, rehabilitation facilities, and health centers.

Real Sex Talk

“Real Sex Talk” is a workshop we created specifically for New York City college students. Inspired by TED talks, it engages students in exploring health messages and tips related to consent, safer sex, and sexual pleasure.

Training Institute

The Training Institute helps professionals stay up-to-date on sexual and reproductive health topics. They can attend one of our 35 annual trainings or arrange a tailored training on site at their agency. We train hundreds of professionals who then reach thousands of community members.

Organizational Capacity Building

PPNYC helps youth- and adult-serving organizations to develop policies, staff knowledge, and resources related to sexual and reproductive health (SRH). We offer information, skills-building opportunities, and educational materials to administrators and staff to enhance their ability to provide SRH education and referrals to their clients. By improving organizations’ systems and environments, we have a broad impact on the people whom they serve.
