**What We Do**

**Sexual and Reproductive Health Services**

Our five health centers in Manhattan, Brooklyn, the Bronx, Queens, and Staten Island provide state-of-the-art sexual and reproductive health care. Whether the need is for contraception, pregnancy tests, abortion services, or tests for sexually transmitted infections, we're here for our patients – regardless of their age, gender, immigration status, or ability to pay. Medical interpretation and translated materials are available for non-English-speaking patients.


We make the most of technology to better serve our patients, from online appointment scheduling to a new telehealth platform, Planned Parenthood Direct, that enables people to get birth control prescriptions or medicine for a urinary tract infection via their phones.

**Clinical Training and Research Initiative**

PPNYC's Clinical Training and Research Initiative (CTRI) trains a wide range of professionals including physicians, nurses, certified nurse-midwives, physician assistants, and nurse practitioners. Our trainings increase the number of clinicians qualified to provide abortion services as well as the full range of sexual and reproductive health services, including the latest methods of long-acting reversible contraception. CTRI also conducts clinical research to advance evidence-based best practices for sexual and reproductive health.


**Our Patients in 2018**

- **56,577** patients made 91,409 visits to our health centers.
- **62%** of our patients were insured by Medicaid, paid reduced rates, or received our services for free.
- **65%** of our patients were under the age of 30.

**Services Available for Patients of All Genders**

- Health insurance enrollment

## Affordable Services


Our doors are open to everyone, regardless of their ability to pay. We help eligible uninsured patients to obtain public insurance or provide care on a sliding fee scale. Each of our health centers has counselors who help patients enroll in public insurance programs such as Medicaid, Child Health Plus, and the Family Planning Benefit Program and in the private insurance plans in the New York State of Health Marketplace. We also cover the costs of long-acting reversible contraceptives for uninsured patients.

## Project Street Beat


Project Street Beat is PPNYC's HIV prevention, harm reduction, and access-to-care program that focuses on the South Bronx, central Brooklyn, and northern Manhattan. Our staff provide health care and support to the city's most marginalized individuals who are at high risk for transmission of HIV and sexually transmitted infections (STI). In the Keith Haring Foundation-Project Street Beat Mobile Health Center and two offices, we offer HIV and STI testing, condoms, PrEP (Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis), PEP (Post-Exposure Prophylaxis), reproductive health care, opioid overdose prevention, syringe distribution and disposal, harm reduction counseling, case management, and more. In 2018, Project Street Beat provided 17,085 services of all types.
